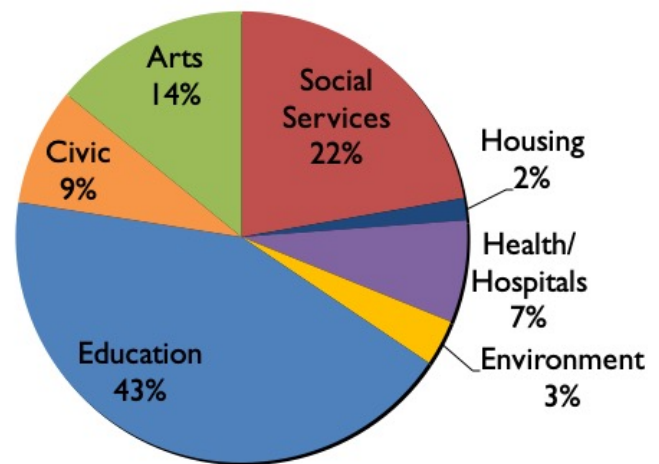


2018 Grant Payments by Program Area

The Longwood Foundation accepts grant applications from non-profit organizations located in and/or benefiting the residents, environment, or culture of the state of Delaware and southern Chester County, Pennsylvania within a four-mile radius of Longwood Gardens. The Foundation operates two grant cycles per year, with approximately 70 applications submitted in each window. There are typically \$2.5 of request for every \$1 available to grant. Decisions are made in May and November, with most payments made shortly thereafter. Occasionally, grant payments for a single request may be paid across multiple years or may be delayed until a contingency or challenge is met. Therefore, grant payments in a given year do not always represent all of the grants awarded by the Trustees.

The information in this document represents grants paid by the Longwood Foundation during 2018. Each request is categorized into one of the seven program areas displayed in the chart to the right. Note that the Foundation's fiscal year differs from the calendar year, and totals will differ from those listed on 990 forms. Grant payments made to Longwood Gardens are not represented here.

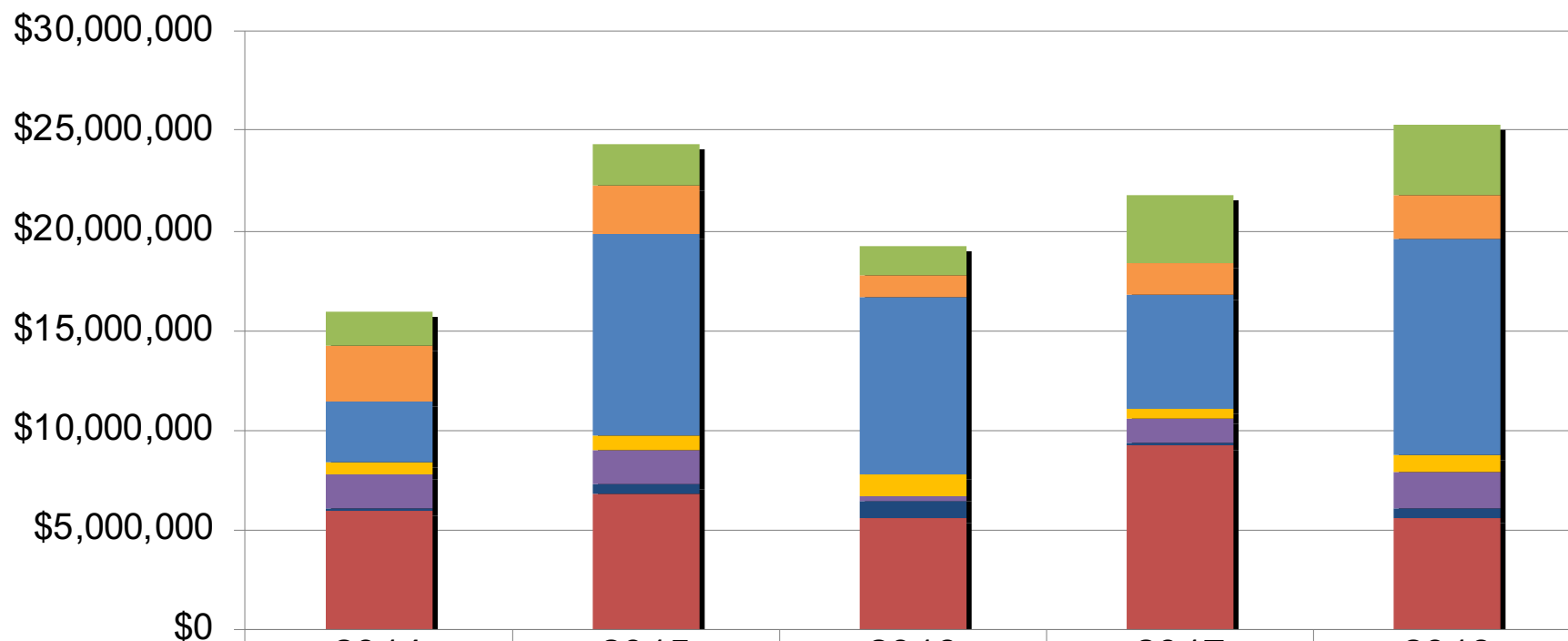
